

ACCOUNTABILITY QUESTIONS

(from CHAT Groups by Dr. Curtis Sergeant)

These questions are to be asked of one another in a regularly scheduled meeting of accountability (Proverbs 27:17). They are to stimulate conversations of character and confession of sin to God and one another in a safe environment which values honesty, vulnerability, confidentiality, and grace.

1. How have you seen God at work?
2. Are you abiding daily in Jesus?
3. Are you disciplined in your rest/sabbath?
4. Have you been sexually pure in your thoughts, words & actions?
5. Have you acknowledge God's ownership in your use of money?
6. Have you coveted anything?
7. Have you hurt someone's reputation or feelings by your words?
8. Have you been dishonest in word or action or exaggerated?
9. Have you given in to an addictive (or lazy or undisciplined) behavior?
10. Have you been a slave to work, or possessions, or schedule?
11. Have you failed to forgive someone?
12. What worries or anxieties are you facing? Have you complained or grumbled? Have you maintained a thankful heart?
13. Have you been honoring, understanding and generous in your important relationships?
(Marriage, parenting, Timothy's)
14. How have you battled pride?
15. Have you lied at all during this gathering?
