Read Luke 24:1-12

Praise God from whom all blessings flow; Praise Him all Creatures here below; Praise Him above ye heavenly hosts; Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost Amen

Praise God for all that He has done; Praise Him for he has overcome; The grave is beaten, Love has won; Praise God, our Savior, Christ the son.

Read Psalm 113

Christ has died, but Christ is risen, and Christ will come again.

We Celebrate his death and rising, We lift our eyes and proclaim his coming. He is our great Redeemer, our glorious Savior. His name is higher than the rising sun. He is the Light of the morning. He shines forever. His name is higher than the rising sun.

Read Luke 24:36-49

My Savior, He can move the mountains. My God is Mighty to save. He is Mighty to save. Forever, Author of salvation, He rose and conquered the grave. Jesus conquered the grave

Read John 11:25-26

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin, Mary. Who suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to darkness. On the third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended to Heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Read Romans 6:3-11
